New Signage for America's Boating Club North Shore

PDC Rich Davidson learned about the opportunity to purchase these signs at the USPS Governing Board Meeting last year. Thanks to a partnership with W.S. Sign Design Corp in Massachusetts, these signs are



available for local clubs to purchase for a reasonable cost.

Past Commander Tony Palazzo presented this to the Executive Committee. After conversations with a few of the marinas in



our area, the Bridge approved the purchase of three signs. Signs are available in different sizes, but we opted for the most common, which is a 30" round sign with America's Boating Club logo and an 8"x24" rectangular information sign. Regardless of your age or experience level, data shows that life jackets save lives. Proper care of life jackets ensures they will work when needed and extends their useful life. Plus fresh, clean life jackets are more desirable to wear while out on the water.

America's Boating Channel[™] produces videos that explain how to properly care for your life jacket, like this one: "Life Jacket Care" (https://youtu.be/iEofd6mUwN4). It also talks about special considerations caring for inflatable and foam-filled life jackets. Foam deteriorates over time, so test each year to ensure your life jacket allows you to float with your mouth out of the water. A serviceable life jacket should keep you afloat for several hours.

Treat your life jacket as though your life depends on it!


