


### **America's Boating Channel Smart TV Launch**

Subscribe now for free to the on-demand app on Roku or FireTV and tune-in to the continuously playing live channel on Sports.TV. To get the app, on Roku, select Store using your Roku remote, select Channels and search for Americas Boating Channel, select Add Channel. On FireTV, go to Apps on your Fire TV Main Menu, search for Americas Boating Channel, select Get to download the app. For the channel, add the Sports.TV app on Roku or FireTV, select Live Channels and scroll down to America's Boating Channel, click the program grid to watch now.


