### A MESSAGE FROM OUR COMMANDER

If any instructor's wants to qualify to distribute these certificates, please contact me and I will let you know how to acquire the material and information. They will advertise our courses on their website, which will help us recruit students and their parents to an ABC class. I believe this is a very important tool for us to use for recruitment. The Illinois certificate is needed for everyone over 12 years of age to be in compliance to operate a boat in Illinois. We can now provide it.

After Cody's excellent presentation we broke for lunch. It was great to see everyone at the conference. Skokie Valley members who attended were Ron and Joanne Zingler, Frank and Karen D'Amico, Dave and Sue Anthony, Stuart Zwang, Richard Davidson, Natalie Witty, Susan and myself. 

### New Class: Save a Life – Learn CPR

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) is an emergency lifesaving procedure performed when the heart stops beating. CPR can double or triple the chances of survival after cardiac arrest. This important skill is one that everyone should know. Learning the basics can be empowering and it is something you will remember throughout your lifetime.

An American Heart Association Heartsaver class has been scheduled for our Skokie Valley members on Saturday, November 5, 2022 from <u>9:00 AM to 12 Noon</u>. The class will be held at the Mount Prospect Fire Station #14 located at 2000 E. Kensington Rd., Mt. Prospect, IL.

The class will cover recognition and emergency resuscitation techniques for heart attack, cardiac arrest, strokes and airway obstruction in adults, children and infants. The class will also cover the use of automated external defibrillators (AED). Upon completion, a certificate will be awarded valid for 2 years.
