#### **BOAT SINKING RULES**

- Let leaves, snow and ice clog the scuppers.
- Don't check hose clamps regularly.
- Don't install double hose clamps on all hoses/fittings.
- Install hose clamps so the excess ring material exits in the same direction.
- Don't shut off the fresh water at the dock every time you leave the boat.
- Don't inspect for tiny tell-tale leaks on a weekly basis.
- 7. Don't double check that the drain plug is in every time you launch.
