



Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) is an emergency lifesaving procedure performed when the heart stops beating. CPR can double or triple the chances of survival after cardiac arrest. This important skill is one that everyone should know. Learning the basics can be empowering and it is something you will remember throughout your lifetime.

An American Heart Association Heartsaver class has been scheduled for our Skokie Valley members on Saturday, November 5, 2022 from <u>9:00 AM to 12 Noon</u>. The class will be held at the Mount Prospect Fire Station #14 located at 2000 E. Kensington Rd., Mt. Prospect, IL.

The class will cover recognition and emergency resuscitation techniques for heart attack, cardiac arrest, strokes and airway obstruction in adults, children and infants. The class will also cover the use of automated external defibrillators (AED). Upon completion, a certificate will be awarded valid for 2 years.

### The BOC Program

It took me seven and a half years to reach Educational Achievement, that is, take every grade and elective course to become a Senior Navigator. I figured I was done, other than teaching classes. Then came the Boat Operator Certification (On the Water Training) program. When I saw people with letters after their grade level, I realized I was not done. The United States Power Squadrons



came to realize that classroom instruction alone does not teach everything you need to know to be a safe boater. So, a hands on instruction curriculum was created to fill that gap.

It comes in four levels – Inland Navigation, Coastal Navigation, Advanced Coastal Navigation, and Offshore Navigation. This is the practical equivalent of Piloting, Advanced Piloting, Junior & Senior Navigation. Remember what you learned in Piloting about doing a running fix? In the CN program, you actually do it on a boat while underway. You learn docking, run a slalom while on plane, anchoring, a pivot turn, man overboard drills, relative bearings, and so on.

The part that is hard to come by is finding a certified instructor to teach and test your boat handling skills. This past July, on a three-day weekend, a rare BOC instructor certification was held in Sturgeon Bay, WI. The instructors included the director and vice-director for the Midwest Region of USPS, a grouping of several districts around Lake Michigan. Class size was limited. Only four of us were there. Two of us passed the IN, CN, and ACN practical course. We have to get CPR, fire extinguisher, and other instruction, but the hard part was behind us. I was one of those two.

Therefore, if you are interested in getting BOC certification, when I finish my paperwork and other requirements, I can offer this to anyone who wants it. Please let me know if you are interested.
